Transitional Curriculum of First Professional BAMS 2025-26 was concluded with precious guidance of Principal Sir and National Anthem.

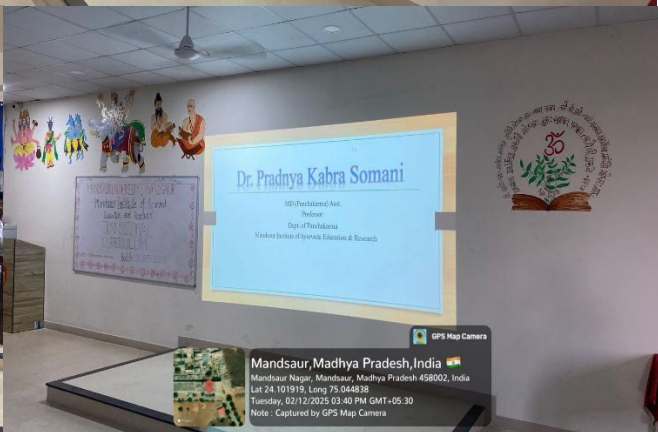
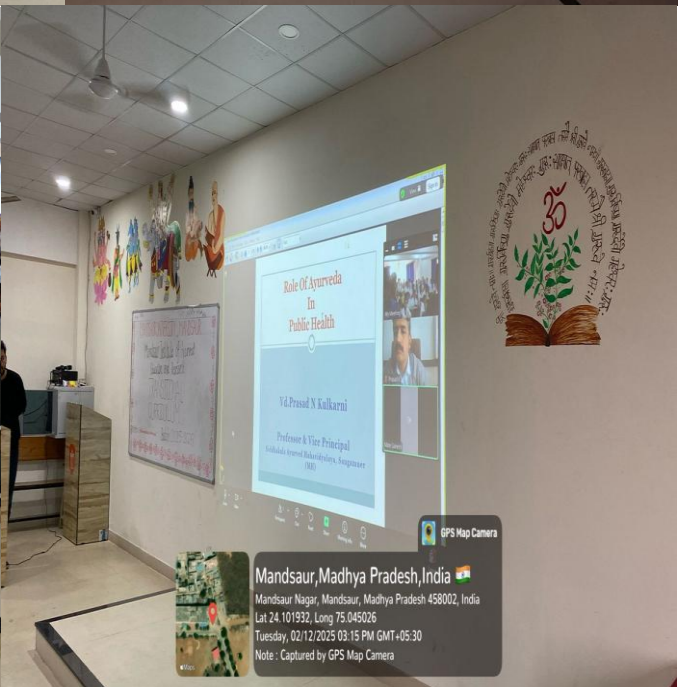
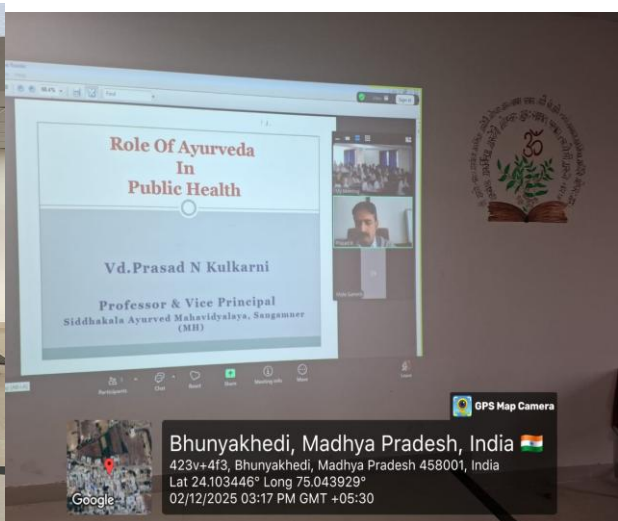
